Specify First Initiative: Participation in a Scholarship Program to assist students interested in a career in broadcasting.

Describe activities undertaken to fulfill that initiative: KREI/KTJJ/KJFF Radio participated in the Missouri Broadcasters Association Foundation Scholarship Program for high school graduates or college attendees interested in a broadcasting career. Ads ran to inform interested students of the scholarship program, inviting them to pick up applications and information at the stations.

Specify Second Initiative: Participation in an Internship Support Program to assist students interested in a career in broadcasting.

Describe activities undertaken to fulfill that initiative: KREI/KTJJ/KJFF Radio participated in the Missouri Broadcasters Association Foundation Internship Support Program. Ads ran on KREI/KTJJ/KJFF to inform students of the internship program, inviting them to pick up applications and information at the stations.

Specify Third Initiative: Internship program designed to assist students to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

Describe activities undertaken to fulfill that initiative: A student at Farmington Senior High School, as part of the school's contracted education program, served as an intern from 02-23-09 through 5-14-09. During her internship she collected news, sports, and announcements for delivering on the air. She wrote and edited news stories, announcements, and interviews. She became proficient in operating all of the equipment used in the news gathering process from the start to the produced product going on air.

Specify Fourth Initiative: Internship program designed to assist students to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

Describe activities undertaken to fulfill that initiative: A student at Missouri State University in Springfield, MO, served as an intern at KREI/KTJJ from 05-25-09 through 07-31-09 to gain a better sense of the broadcasting field. She was on-air with full-time morning host, Mark Toti, voiced commercials, and was the on-air voice for local news and sports for the morning show. She also worked behind the scenes gathering news and sports, and interviewing local community residents.
